



Highlights


The TSP issued quarterly statements to participants in April, reflecting activity for the first three months of 2025. The TSP remains the largest defined contribution plan in the United States with more than 7.25 million accounts -- a new plan high. There are nearly 2.8 million Roth TSP accounts, also a new plan high. The TSP plans to offer Roth in-plan conversion as a new feature beginning in January 2026.


