


Thrift Savings Fund Statistics

Highlights

The FERS participation rate rose above 87% for the first time since July 2004. The civilian average account balances are climbing to the \$100,000 mark with both FERS and CSRS average account balances slightly above \$95,000. The number of Roth accounts has increased over 20,000 per month since November, and we are noticing a gradual shift from the G Fund to C, S, and L funds.



Historic Plan Balances (in millions)


Fund Balances (% of total plan balance)















Historic FERS Participation Rates





Historic Participant Counts (in thousands)
