


Thrift Savings Fund Statistics

May 2013

Highlights

The total plan balance climbed to over \$358 billion during the month of May, while the FERS participation rate remained steady at 87%. After reaching the one-year anniversary of the implementation of Roth TSP, there are 203,092 participants with Roth balances totaling nearly \$415 million. Of note, year-to-date net cash flows totaled \$3.5 billion versus \$5.3 billion for the same period in 2012, reflecting a significant increase in post-separation withdrawals.



Historic Plan Balances (in millions)


Fund Balances (% of total plan balance)











Cash Flow Attributes






Historic FERS Participation Rates





Historic Participant Counts (in thousands)
