


Thrift Savings Fund Statistics

Highlights

The FERS participation dropped slightly from 86.7% in August to 86.4% in September. The number of separated participants who retain their TSP accounts continues to grow. Separated participants constitute nearly 24% of all TSP accounts. The number of participants with Roth balances increased by 4.5% to a total of 249,034 participants, while Roth balances increased to nearly \$690 million.



Historic Plan Balances (in millions)

Fund Balances (% of total plan balance)













Historic FERS Participation Rates







Historic Participant Counts (in thousands)
