



Highlights

The FERS participation rate remained steady at 89.3%, while the active duty Uniformed Services participation rate increased to 44.4% for the first time in plan history. The total numbers of participants are now over 4.9 million with total plan asset of over \$465 billion. About 15% of the participants hold Roth accounts. Initial monthly payments, which were high at the end of 2015 and early 2016 from increased retirements, are now starting to level off.





Fund Balances (% of total plan balance)








Cash Flow Attributes




Participation Rates (current month)




Participant Composition (current month in thousands)



Historic FERS Participation Rates





Historic Participant Counts (in thousands)






Post-Separation Withdrawals



Post-Separation Withdrawals Single Payments (Cash & Transfers)








