

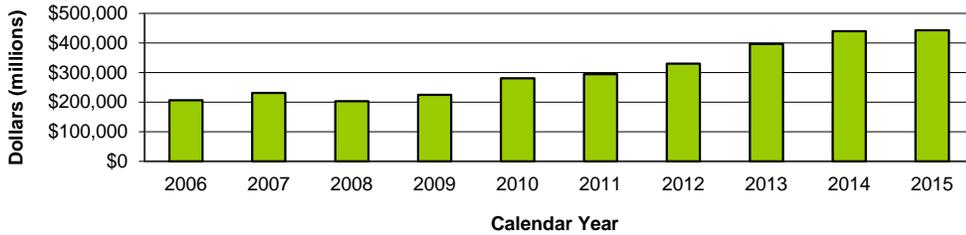
# Thrift Savings Fund Statistics

August 2016

## Highlights

Participation rates have leveled out with FERS at 89.4% for the last 4 months and Uniformed Services at 44.9% for the last 2 months. Since January 2015 the number of Roth accounts has nearly doubled from 494,048 to 807,129 while aggregate Roth balances have more than doubled from \$2.2 billion to \$5.2 billion. We continued to have robust roll-in activity with totals of \$104 million for the month of August.




## Fund Balances (% of total plan balance)








## Cash Flow Attributes




**Participation Rates (current month)**




**Participant Composition (current month in thousands)**



**Historic FERS Participation Rates**





**Historic Participant Counts (in thousands)**






**Post-Separation Withdrawals**



**Post-Separation Withdrawals Single Payments (Cash & Transfers)**


